

Rules and Guidelines for overnight parking at The Tichborne Arms

FOR PAYING CUSTOMERS ONLY

- Overnight parking is exclusively for paying customers.
- While we do not charge a parking fee, it is expected that you support our business by purchasing food and drinks during your stay.

REGISTRATION & CAPACITY

- All camper vans must be registered in advance – preferably by email to pub@tichbornearms.com or by calling 01962 588346.
- In order to confirm parking, you will require a booking to dine with us – you can book a table online, in person, by phone or by email
- A maximum of 2 camper vans are permitted to park overnight on Fridays, Saturdays & Sundays. A maximum of 3 Monday-Thursday.

QUIET HOURS

 Please observe quiet hours from 10:00 PM to 8:00 AM out of respect for other guests and local residents.

DESIGNATED PARKING ONLY

- Camper vans must park within one of the clearly marked spaces in the main car park.
- Overnight parking is not permitted in the field overflow car park under any circumstances.

STAY DURATION

 Maximum stay is 1 night, unless agreed with management in advance. Please note that additional nights will not be considered at weekends during the summer months.

FACILITIES

- There are no electrical or water hookups available. Please arrive selfcontained and prepared
- Toilets and hand washing facilities are available during pub opening hours.

NO OUTDOOR ITEMS

No items may be placed outside your camper van, including:

- · Camping chairs
- Tables
- Barbecues
- · Awnings or external storage
- BBQs, chimineas or fire pits

WASTE & RUBBISH

- No rubbish bins or disposal facilities are provided for camper vans.
- You must take all rubbish, grey water, and waste with you when you leave.

SECURITY & RESPONSIBILITY

 Vehicles are parked entirely at your own risk. We accept no responsibility for loss or damage to vehicles or personal belongings, or any personal injury incurred whilst camping.
